- 3. Fill out the <u>Agricultural Management Plan</u>. This document is used to describe the agricultural, open space, or recreational use on your property that qualifies the property for the Williamson Act. If you do not know a previous contract number, Agricultural Preserve Number, or Resolution Number, you may leave these sections blank. Please fill out this form completely as possible. An Agricultural use should generate at least \$2000 gross per year.
- 4. Please provide a map of parcel(s) showing structures, ponds, wells, etc.
