BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING - APRIL 8, 1990

The Board of Directors meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Vice President Wayne Harvey. All members present except Pernetti, excused.

MINUTES - Minutes of Mar. 11, 1990 meeting were read and approved.

CARETAKERS REPORT General maintenance, water system repair, garbage clean up, normal patrol.

CORRESPONDENCE: - 1. Letter from D. Girling saying that they are satisfied with their water. 2. Letter from D. Moody stating that he does not want a filtration system. 3. Letter from Peoples stating that they do not want a filtration system. 4. Letter from P. Chernikoff asking about the water ballot. We will include a water ballot with the notice of the annual meeting which will be sent out in May.

MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD - 1. Steve Hulet - asking for information about parking area retaining walls. 2. Robert Henry - asking permission to cut 3 trees in front of his property. MSC to give permission to cut 3 trees shown on the drawing provided they are within the extension of his side boundary lines. 3. Walt Evans - requesting information about the bill the board sent him. 4. Gary Whiteman - requesting information concerning a driveway in front of his house. 5. John Wylie - asking for legal access to the five acre parcel along Jordan Way West. 6. Ray Hawkes - offering to help with machinery. 7. Steve Hulet - asking the board to consider setting aside an area for storage of items such as boats, campers, etc. 8. Vince Perry - observer.

COMMITTEE REPORTS WATER - Dale Smith - Water use 2,180,100 gallons. Lead content: 50 mg is the allowable amount. 10 mg is the smallest measurable amount. Ours is not measurable, hence less than 10 mg.

ROADS - Dale Smith - Some patching has been started.

BUILDINGS - Mitchell - Termite inspection of the Rec. Hall has begun.

TIMBER - Adams - No report.

EQUIPMENT - Harvey - Normal maintenance, new tires on the front of the dump truck.

RECREATION - Unruh - There will be a barbecue on June 17, 1990 with hot dogs and soda for children. Adults bring your own food and beverages. There will be a fishing derby for children. More later.

FINANCE - Zobel - Bills were presented in the amount of \$111.70 for the Homeowners Assoc., \$5,403.74 for the Rec. Assoc. MSC to pay the bills. Income: H.O.A. \$354.31.

OLD BUSINESS - Ballots for the iron/manganese issue will be mailed out with next months news letter. Please vote promptly and remember that non-returned ballots will count as a vote in favor of the water system filters. MSC to proceed with a closure gate across the gravel road leading to the spring with a sign attached saying "No Motorized Vehicle Beyond This Point".

NEW BUSINESS - We will disconnect well #3 from the water system because the well is not producing adequate water. This way we will save on water testing. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:00 AM. The next regular meeting will be held May 6, 1990.

The Annual Meeting will be held May 27, 1990.
