CARETAKERS REPORT Equipment maintenance, general maintenance, water system, road repair, bar ditches, garbage clean up, Rec. Hall, normal patrol.

CORRESPONDENCE: - 1. A letter from Dodge Ridge complaining that we did not "roll out the red carpet" to one of their employees who was trying to rent in Odd Fellows. 2. A letter from Robert Hintz resigning as president of the Board of Directors due to business commitments. 3. A letter from Cal-Sierra Disposal increasing rates. 4. A letter from Cedar Brook Trustees stating that they will have a representative at the February 10 meeting.

MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD - 1. Mr. Wylie - Made a proposal to have his five acre parcel made part of Odd Fellows. 2. Mr. Hawkes - observer. 3. Mr. & Mrs. Valentine - observers. 4. Bert Johnson - water reference & reminded the Board that he did not get paid for the month of November.

COMMITTEE REPORTS WATER - Dale Smith - Water use 1,690,400 gallons. The state has informed us that we have a high iron and manganese content in our water. We must act on this so you will receive more information on this next month. This is not a health problem.

ROADS - Dale Smith - No report.

BUILDINGS - Mitchell - Filled in the lake. MSC to insulate the ceiling in the caretakers cabin and the firehouse.

TIMBER - No report.

HEALTH AND SAFETY - Harvey - Street signs are being made and put in place. Fees for the dumpster have gone up 33% so please use the dumpster properly so it does not have to be emptied as often.

EQUIPMENT - Harvey - The tractor has been repaired. The front end of the snow plow is not working properly and will probably not last through the winter. Thanks to Pete Dax we have obtained parts for the water truck. Pete also repaired lights on the water truck.

RECREATION - Unruh - On February 10, 1990 there will be a Valentine Day Pot-luck. Bring two dishes. Lodge meeting will be at 6:00 with the Pot-luck at 6:30 PM.

FINANCE - Zobel - Bills were presented in the amount of \$238.55 for the Homeowners Assoc., \$11,401.41 for the Rec. Assoc. and \$104.00 for the Timber Fund. MSC to pay the bills. Income: Homeowners \$1,924.78

NEW BUSINESS - The Board feels Dale Smith is doing a good job as caretaker. He has accomplished a great deal. MSC to regretfully accept the resignation of Robert Hintz. MSC to pay the caretaker on the first of the month instead of on the date of the Board Meeting. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11 AM. The next regular meeting will be held February 11, 1990.
