Sauce for Corned Beef

Blend:

2 Tablespoons Salad Oil

1/3 Cup Brown Sugar (or syrup)

Add and stir:

5 Tablespoons Catsup

3 Tablespoons Vinegar

1 Tablespoon Mustard

Bring it to a boil and then let it simmer a while.

Very simple and quick.

#### **Minutes**

MSC to approve minutes of February 2, 1997, meeting with correction to total of bills for the month.

#### Members Before the Board

Maynard Wallin commended the Board on work done at he lake and at the creek.

### Caretakers Report

Painted the gate building and built shelf for monitor, and VCR. Painted trim in the restrooms in the recreation hall.

Redirected the creek so water goes to the creek and lake.

Repaired two teeth on the backhoe, 12" bucket.

Checked and repaired water leak in front of Birdsell cabin.

Checked on condition of road in front of Overracker cabin. Will have Jim Morrison look at it.

Went with Fred Coleman to see about closing of back roads to the park.

Moved rocks from Long Barn Ranch Road.

Repaired water leak on Jordan way.

Cleaned up burn area and sectioned it off into two sections with signs.

Roped off walking bridge to lake and placed "Stay off Bridge" sign until railings are completed.

Burned off branches and needles from camp ground area.

 $\mbox{\it Had}$  Park truck repaired; brakes, emergency brake, and  $\mbox{\it CV}$  joints.

Made sign for the dumpster.

Replaced and repaired log fence in front of the lake.

Repaired culverts in walking trails to the lake.

Moved willow piles to burn area from lake area.

Pulled door lock out of board room and had it keyed the same as other locks.

Built and installed the gate on the dirt road off of Rebecca.

Cleaned ditches on Jordan Way, Abraham, and Moses.

Skidded trees to Jordan Way bridge and cleaned out creek bed to lake.

### Committee Reports

Water-Bowman: Water usage for this month was 310,000. Roads-Morrison: Waiting for bids from George Reed, Inc. on road repair.

**Buildings**-Hawke: Thanks to Randy for all building repairs and maintenance. Blinds for the hall are on order. Recommendations: Construct pump building with sloped roof to house the generator and fuel. Three window panes need to be replaced in front of the Recreation Hall. Siding in back of hall should be removed as it has dry rot damage. Pit between building and parking area needs draining to prevent water from going under the building. Change lattice to a sun screen at lake as it will require less upkeep.

Timber-Hague: No action on timber until April.

**Recreation-**Snell: Good turnout for the corned beef and cabbage dinner. The next event will be the spaghetti dinner on May 24, the day before the annual meeting on May 25. The fish derby will be held on June 12. There was a suggestion that smaller fish be planted. The hatcheries will be contacted for price.

**Health and Safety**-Coleman: Continued problem with dogs running loose in the park. We have a county leash law.

**Finance**-Bonner: Bills for the month totaled \$11,011.11. MSC for bills to be paid.

#### Old Business

The purchase of Oliver Armstrong's plumber's vice for \$50 and a thatcher rake for \$150. (Petty cash will be used to purchase necessary items.) An engraver should be purchased. MSC to purchase a dump kit for the flat bed sand truck and a hitch. Total cost \$2850.

#### **New Business**

Discussion concerning the need for a part-time secretary. Our new secretary is Cathy Bowman, wife of our new director Tracy Bowman. Welcome aboard Cathy.

No further business appearing, the meeting was closed at 10:00 A.M. The next meeting will be April 13, 1997.
