FISH DERBY-- FATHER'S DAY JUNE 21-

Our annual Fish derby will be held on Fathers day Sunday June 21. All kids 15 years old or younger are welcome to participate. The entry fee this year will be \$1.00. You may register your children either on June 20, at the picnic grounds, or at the derby. The fishing time this year will be 8:00 AM to 10:30. A Pot luck picnic will be held at the picnic grounds at 12:00PM, where the derbe presentations will be held. Last year 84 children caught 129 fish so come and enjoy.

In final and most important-- After the fish are planted, there will be no fishing untill the derby, and afterwards untill the lake is fished out only children under

16 will be permitted to fish in the lake-- the limit and hours of fishing will be daylight only and a limit of 10 fish a day.

This doesnt count those going out of the park fishing before 7. Do not drive in the meadow or down by the lake. Dont drive on others lots unless you have their permission.

U. S. Forest Service- Requesting the Park comply with fire prevention efforts- The Park has already complied with request.

Tuolumne Count Special Olympics- Requesting the park become an official "S.O.B." member.Special Olympics Booster. No action required.

Tracy, Warren- Sent letter to Board- regarding one way street signs and the use of raads by the caretaker. Action has been delayed pending discussion at the annual meeting.

Water: Bell- Water distribution maps are progressing. Small "working" maps showing roads and lots will be for sale at the annual meeting.

Equipment: Gibson- General Maintanance being performed.

Recreation- Harmer- A new float has been placed in the lake. The fish derby will be held on June 21, 8:00 AM to 10:30 AM. The picnic and awards presentation will begin at 12:00 PM. Registration will start at 12:00 PM on June 20. The cost is \$1.00 per child (15 years of age or younger). Volunteers are needed to help judge. Please contact Akers of Harmer if you wish to help.

Request by George Garner and Josephine Graves to rent the Recreation hall on August 2. Motion by Wallis, sec. by Gibson, The request be approved, and the date reserved once a deposit has been received.

A discussion was held on commercial interests wanting to rent the recreation hall. Motio n by Stephenson Sec. by Akers to charge\$40.00 per hour without the use of the kitchen facilities, with a \$25.00 cleaning deposit, all payable in advance.

Individuals wishing to use the kitchen fascilities will be charged \$20.00 per hour with a \$50.00 deposit, all payable in advance. Passed.

With the above figures, and including the Timber Harvest Income, the Park would be paying Income Taxes of Approx. \$6500. If 10,000 more expenses were added the tax would be reduced to \$4500, and an additional 10,000 expense would reduce taxes to \$2800.
