There will be work on the roads this summer BUILDINGS -Smith - The fire department will be invited to destroy the buildings on the 5 acre parcel as a practice session.
TIMBER -Adams-Tim Tate has been cruising and marking some trees RECREATION - Hawke - There will be a spaghetti dinner on May 27th, 4:30 to 6:00 PM. \$5.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children.
