Met with state water agent to meet state water regulations on iron and manganese contents in water. Second reading "Cross Connection Ordinance #2. M/Pernetti, S/Unruh to change our testing from Cal Water Labs to Aqua Labs in Twain Harte. Carried. ROADS -Bradley - Marking and surveying roads is completed. Road repair will start during August.
