CARETAKERS REPORT - Special thanks to Glen Mitchell & Joe Frietas for volunteer work on repairing roads. The park has a 36" propane cook stove in excess. It will be donated to a homeowner on a first-come, first-served basis.

CORRESPONDENCE -The annual homeowners barbecue will be held Sept.6. Letters from: 1. Bill Kilgore requesting use of the picnic area on Sept.13,1992. 2. Letter of complaint re July fourth camping in the day use area. The matter will be referred to property owners with the admonition to comply with park rules. 8. The Board received two volunteers for the Ad Hoc Committee; they were to be referred to Mark Bradley. MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD -1. Don Strand & Bud Shimmon (Lot 33 on Abraham) - The Board reaffirms CC&R provisions for homeowner access across Park property to each homeowner's residence. 2. Siobhan De Felice - Financial advice for investment of funds for protecting capital and tax sheltering. Referred to the treasurer. COMMITTEE REPORTS -WATER -Smith-Keller-Water use: 768,000 gals. are operating manually until the concrete tank can be replaced. The rust was ground down and the steel tank spot painted. A report was The made on planning for replacing the concrete tank. The Board identified replacement as a priority item to be funded out of cash flow. MSC to spend up to \$250 for temporary repair of the concrete tank pending replacement by a steel tank,

ROADS -Morrison -This years program is about 95% complete and within budget. MSC to add a portion of Rebekah at up to \$1000 beyond budget to repair surface deterioration.

BUILDINGS -Tolbert - The new stove was installed in the Rec. Hall by Randy Tolbert. We will delete the electric service to the corporation yard shed.

TIMBER -Adams - \$11,866.00 was received for bug kill 1991 timber salvage; Tax and Forestry bills will reduce the net by up to about \$2000.

RECREATION - Clifton - The annual Steak barbecue will be held on Sept. 6 from 4 PM to 6 PM. The menu will include beans, corn, salad, bread, drinks, watermelon. Prices will be \$5.00 for steak dinner and \$2.00 for children's hot dogs. One cord of split pine will be raffled @ \$1.00 per chance. A soft drink vending machine will be auctioned. Both of these are to benefit the annual fish derby. HEALTH AND SAFETY -Green & Tolbert - MSC to install "PRIVATE ROAD" and "NO PARKING" signs for up to \$175.00 out of Building Budget item. The Board will send letters to owners and tenants for repeated speeding in the park, advising of future assessable fines. This is a reminder to all that there is a 20 mile per hour limit throughout the park. If you do not have your street number installed, please do so. This is a fire department requirement and for your benefit. EQUIPMENT -Cloak -The tractor repairs incurred a bill of \$251.00. All equipment is in good shape. MSC to restrict snow plow to in-park use only and to drop collision coverage for \$2400 annual savings. FINANCE -Zebel -Bills for Homeowners Association: \$32,235.00. Bills for Recreation Association: \$16,798.62. Bills for Timber checking \$1,594.50. MSC to pay the bills.

OLD BUSINESS -Assessments are about one half paid. Homeowners are reminded that penalty bills will be mailed Sept. 1,1992.

NEW BUSINESS -MSC to reopen stump disposal for in-park stumps only. MSC to announce "NO OPEN FIRES IN THE PARK" for the duration of the fire season. MSC to purchase 15 gallons of paint and 2 gallons of thinner for painting the water tank.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:10 PM. The next regular meeting will be held September 13,1992 at 9:00 AM.
